The Shakespeare Show

- OUTLINE -

Professional poets and actors present short dramatised excerpts from the Bard's works. They also perform original poems that are inspired by plays such as Romeo and Juliet, Macbeth, The Merchant of Venice, Julius Caesar and As You Like It.

Our artists will deploy current 'pop forms' of literature and interactive theatre to present rhythm, poetry and themes in Shakespeare's original works.

The programme can be customised to meet the desired outcome of an institution.

- a) To promote the spoken poetry of Shakespeare as found in his plays and sonnets
- b) To present the rich complexity and emotional directness of Shakespearean texts
- c) To demonstrate how Shakespeare can be made even more engaging by utilizing choral elements and group performances
- d) To demystify Shakespeare's works by juxtaposing it with original poetry written by our performance poets
- e) To show how Shakespeare captures the range of human emotions in simple yet profoundly eloquent verses that transcend time and culture
